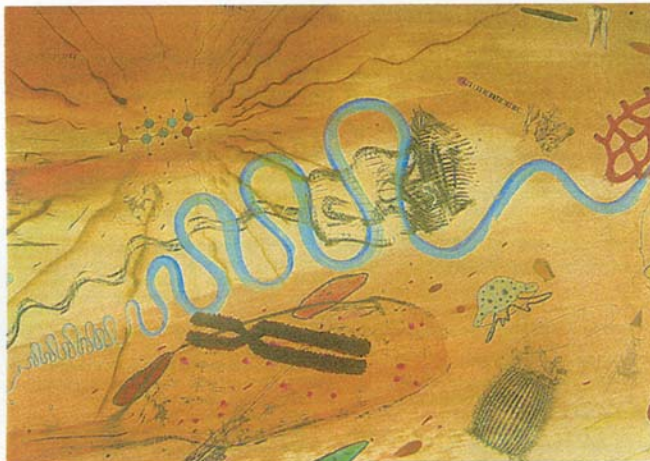

The art of construction A huge new public artwork inspired by the Human Genome Project, the international effort to produce a genetic map of humankind, is due to be unveiled in north London on Monday. The 370-foot by 10-foot hoarding has been commissioned by The Wellcome Trust on giant graffiti-proof panels around the construction site at its new headquarters at 183 Euston Rd (Euston tube). Award-winning New York artist Jason Middlebrook worked closely with his brother Aaron, an immunologist, to create 'The Geology of Biology: Inspired by the Sequencing of the Human Genome', which features giant DNA strands, plant cells, brains, sperms, eggs, roots and protozoa. The original painting will be displayed inside the Wellcome Building, designed by Michael Hopkins and Partners, which is scheduled for completion in 2004.
